1. OWNERSHIP:

3. AGE, NO. OF CAMPERS PER CAMP & DIVERSITY

- 3.3 a minimum of five (5) Campers and, or a maximum of ten (10) Campers per Group/School is permitted.

4. ACCOMMODATION

- 4.2. A subsequent call will be arranged a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the start date of the Camp.
- 4.3. Dang Lang Island will be the official destination where all youths would be staying on, and accommodation will not be in Tents, instead in individually customized chalets with shower and lavatory facilities.
- 4.4. A max. of 5 persons is permitted in each customized chalets. Allotments can be requested by Parents/Schools through formal requests made directly by the Personin Charge (PIC). No allotments will be made on requests by youths participating at the Camp.

- 4.5. Each youth would be accorded a sleeping bag and its remains the responsibility of each youth to maintain and not damage their individual sleeping bag.
- 4.6. If 4:1 assistance is requested, we will provide you with a form to submit any necessary information then work with you to identify reasonable accommodation if available. It is the responsibility of the Parent/School to cover any accommodation costs associated with their request. While a request cannot be guaranteed, all accommodation inquiries will be reviewed to ensure safety and program integrity.
- 4.7. Participants should have the basic skills to be self-sufficient, adhere to the behavior policy and be willing to participate in adventurous, creative and imaginative processes with peers. We produce high-energy experiences through various activities, programs and workshops, and at times highly stimulating.
- 4.8. Participants will be engaged with Camp Instructors throughout the day for each activity, which would mainly comprise of outdoor settings.

10. REFUND POLICY & CANCELLATION INSURANCE:

- 10.1. RM 400.00 or USD 110.00 of each Registration Fee is non-refundable.
- 10.2. the remaining balance is refundable three (3) weeks prior to the start date of the Camp.
- 10.3. cancellations made after this time are non-refundable, as materials and educator costs are allocated and final.
- 10.4. please keep in mind Cancellation Insurance may only be purchased at the time of Registration for an additional RM100.00 or USD45.00 per participant per day, which covers the Registration cost should a Parent need to cancel, less the Insurance fee.

11. RULES

You, together with all members of your party, are required to comply with the following rules:

- 11.1. we only accept responsible Campers that are considerate to fellow Campers and respectful of the environment and wildlife.
- 11.2. there cannot be any disrupting noise/s after 22:00 hrs and before 07:00 hrs, unless it's an activity-oriented program as per stated in Camp Itinerary & Schedule of Daily Programs.
- 11.3. campsite is located on the island and strictly for accommodation-purposes, and must be kept clean at all times with no litter or any damage/s. You will be liable for any damages and, or excess cleaning.
- 11.4. the island is body of land surrounded by water, and accompanied with surrounding islands, the environmental remains a fragile eco-system as a result of its size, shape and degree characteristics. However, these same characteristics also make islands vulnerable ecosystems as islands are generally known to have the highest proportion of recorded species extinctions, as such emphasis will be placed on conservation and preservation efforts.
- 11.5. the use of electrical devices is controlled due to limited power-supply via solar power on the island.
- 11.6. we cannot accept responsibility for any loss of your possessions or any personal injury of any kind sustained before and after the Camp, and will only be responsible from the period ASIA Youth Camp commences (Nov 13 17, 2023) subject to Point 15 Liability Waiver; as all activities, programs and workshops conducted are in safe surroundings. You must not stray on your own. This is for your own personal safety.

- 11.7. no open fires are allowed. BBQs are permitted if raised off the ground to protect the grass.
- 11.8. on the island, you and any members of your party must not enter any building premises without prior permission, apart for the convenience facilities provided i.e. toilet/s and shower facilities;
- 11.9. you must be responsible for your individual wastage i.e. plastic, paper, rubbish, etc. Only general food waste and packaging is to be disposed of on the island's bins. You may be liable to a RM 120.00 or USD 30.00 surcharge if we end up having to dispose of such wastage items.
- 11.10. all Campers will be provided with a full Schedule of Daily Program/s, and punctuality for each and all activities, programs and workshops must be adhered to.

12. ACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR POLICY
